# Competition Program

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We will have a program for children who actively compete. The Competition Team portion of the day will take place in the afternoons beginning at 1pm. It will include class, workouts, film study, and extra drilling.

**This program is required for students competing at the Pan Kids for Crazy 88.**

Competitors are encouraged to do the full day camp to be a part of the fun activities and field trips in the morning. Competitors are also encouraged to stay for evening classes.

**The minimum required rank for this program is gray and white belt based on the curriculum and class structure.**

The afternoon martial arts class will be split into beginners and competitors. The competitors will then continue their extra training afterwards.

Some of these activities are offered during academic time, while others are done together as a group earlier in the day.



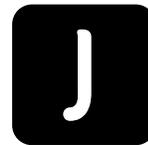

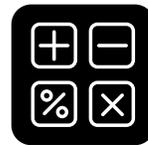

# A Typical Day

9am

## Morning Play

We will either go into the mat room with bounce houses and mat games OR go outside and play with the water, basketball, and other outdoor games.

11am

## Lunch Time

We will wrap up games to eat lunch. After lunch we will either do arts & crafts, card games, board games, and/or legos.

1pm

## Martial Arts

Everyone will go back to the mats to do a martial arts lesson. This is when the Competition Team Program begins. Children will be split by skill level.

2pm

## Academics

This is when we will take an hour for quiet academics. More information on that in the following pages.

3pm

## Mat Games

After academics, we will finish the day with more games! An afternoon snack will be offered around this time.

4pm

## Pick Up + Class

We will wind down and allow electronics at this time. This is when regular pick up held. Coaches will get any kids ready to attend evening classes.

# Shuttle Service

Based on current summer camp attendance at our Severna Park and Owings Mills locations, we will be shuttling campers to our Elkridge location on certain days to ensure the best possible camp experience.

Elkridge offers a larger facility, a greater number of campers to interact with, and additional staff support, allowing us to maintain high-energy activities, strong supervision, and a more dynamic camp environment.

The current plan is as follows:

Severna Park campers will shuttle to Elkridge every camp day.

Owings Mills campers will shuttle to Elkridge Monday through Thursday, with Fridays remaining on site in the event of low attendance.



## Daily Shuttle Schedule

Campers will depart their home location by 9:30am and return by 3:00pm each day.

To ensure safe and smooth coordination between locations, any early pick-ups, late drop-offs, or absences must be communicated at least 48 hours in advance.

This adjustment allows us to maintain the level of engagement, structure, and supervision we expect for our campers while continuing to prioritize safety and quality programming.

### **Who can attend Crazy 88 Summer Camp?**

Our camp is designed for children ages 6–12, and we welcome both Crazy 88 members and non-members.

### **When does camp run?**

Elkridge & Owings Mills: 9 Weeks from June 22<sup>nd</sup> to August 21<sup>st</sup>

Severna Park: 5 Weeks from July 6<sup>th</sup> to August 7<sup>th</sup>

### **What should I pack for lunch and snacks?**

Please pack a full lunch and 2 separate snacks that do not require refrigeration or a microwave. We do not provide access to refrigerators or microwaves, and all food must be nut-free.

### **Are martial arts classes required?**

Yes. We ask that every camper participate in at least one martial arts class during the week. If a child chooses not to continue training, they may sit and watch, but must remain in the training room with the rest of the group.

### **Do I need to purchase a gi (uniform)?**

Yes. A Crazy 88 uniform (gi) is required for participation in martial arts classes. Gi's are sold at each facility and must be purchased before the first day of camp. Please note that counselors cannot sell gi's during the camp day, so we recommend visiting ahead of time to ensure your child is ready.

### **What kinds of field trips do the campers take?**

We frequent local playgrounds, parks, and libraries. During bad weather, we stay indoors and do laser tag/nerf wars and bounce houses.
